- Army Rect rally will be held for eligible candidates.** All eligible candidates of **Nagaur** district for Sol GD, Sol Tech, Sol NA/NA (Vet), Sol Clk/SKT/IM and Sol Tdn from **10 Jun 19** to **20 Jun19** at **District Sports Stadium, Nagaur (Rajasthan)**. **Gates will be open at 0300 hrs and will be closed by 0700 hrs on each day.**
- Registration Process.** Online registration is mandatory Sol GD, Sol Tech, Sol NA/NA (Vet), Sol Clk/SKT/IM and Sol Tdn categories and will be open 09 Apr to 23 May 2019.

5. Candidates are required to bring following documents / certificates in original with two attested photocopies with them to the rally site:-

- (a) **Admit Card.** Printed on Laser Printer on good quality paper (Do not shrink the size).
- (b) **Certificates :-**
- (i) **Education Certificate.** Education Certificates with marks sheet of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e Matric /Intermediate/Graduation etc from recognized School/College/Board/University.
- (ii) Provisional/online education certificate should be certified and signed by the head of the education institution of concerned Board/University.
- (iii) **Open School/NIOS.** Candidates with metric certificate from open school should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by BEO/DEO. Candidate studied from NIOS, required to produce transfer cert (TC) of class 8th/9th duly countersigned by the respective District Education Officer to authenticate its correctness
- (iv) Degree holder candidate will produce Provisional/Original Degree issued by University. .
- (c) **Domicile Certificate.** Domicile certificate with photographs, issued by Tehsildar/ District Magistrate.
- (d) **Caste Certificate.** Caste Certificate affixed with photograph of the candidate, issued by the Tehsildar / District Magistrate.
- (e) **Religion Certificate.** Religion certificate issued by the Tehsildar / SDM. (If religion as “**SIKH / HINDU / MUSLIM / CHRISTIAN**” is not mentioned in caste certificate).
- (f) **School Character Certificate.** School Character Certificate issued by the School/College Principal/ Headmaster.
- (g) **Character Certificate.** Character Certificate with photograph issued by village Sarpanch/Municipal Corporation **within six months.**
- (h) **Unmarried Certificate.** Unmarried certificate for candidates less than 21 yrs of age with photographs issued by village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation **within six months.**
- (j) **Relation Certificate.** SOS / SOEX/ SOW/ SOWW candidates are required to produce the following documents:-
- (i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Records office only duly signed by Records Officer with Personal number, Rank, Name and particulars of the Records officer issuing the Relation certificate with office seal / stamp is endorsed.
- (ii) A declaration to the affect as mentioned below in Affidavit on minimum Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1st class/ Executive/Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidates at rally site. The ESM will mention particular of all sons including name, dat of birth and their employment/occupation in the affidavit and declare that” I am willing to avail SOEX benefits for only one son name___, whose Date of Birth is __. I have not availed SOS/SOEX benefits for another son earlier, if my statements is found fake /wrong at later state, legal action can be initiated against me besides candidature of my son will be cancelled by the military authority. I Shall never challenge for the same in the Hon’ble Court of Law.”
- (iii) Original Discharge Book of ESM also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.
- (k) **NCC Certificate.** NCC A/B/C certificates and Republic Day parade certificate should have photographs of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. **Provisional NCC A/B/C pass certificates will only be accepted if authenticate by concerned NCC Group Commanders.**
- (l) **Sports Certificate.**
- (i) Sportsmen who have represented India at International level and State at National level within the last two years. For list of sports under which relaxation in physical standards is admissible attention is invited to www.joinindianarmy.nic.in website.

(ii) Sportsmen who have represented District at State level and University team or regional team at district level with 1st /2nd position within last two years. Sports certificate should be with registration number and from Govt recognized sports institutes/bodies as under :-

- (aa) All Sr/Jr National Championship Certificates - Respective National Federation.
- (ab) All State & Distt level certificates - Respective State Sports Association.
- (ac) All University level certificates - Inter University Sports Board.
- (ad) All school level certificates - All India School Games Federation.

(m) **Affidavit.** Should be downloaded from individual user ID created on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in and duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-judicial stamp paper and attested by notary. Same should be submitted alongwith documents at rally site.

(n) **AADHAR Card.** Aadhar Card is mandatory document for the rally purpose.

(o) Candidate below the age of 18 years should bring the certificate duly signed by the parents/guardians and attested by village Sarpanch, stating that the **“I am sending my son name _____ date of birth _____ for recruitment in Army on my own interest and there is no objection on him joining the Army. I shall not ask for any compensation due to any injury/illness sustained by my son during screening”**.

Special Instructions. (Peculiar to Rtg Zone if any) (Example)

6. **Special Instructions**

- (a) Candidates are allowed to take part in only one category during the recruitment rally.
- (b) Recruitment is purely based on merit list depending on available vacancies. Candidates do not have any right to claim for recruitment in the Army just by passing in the recruitment process.
- (c) If any candidate requires correction due to wrong entry data on the web site, he may report to Recruiting Office (HQ), Jaipur (Raj) on working days between 0900 hrs to 1400hrs alongwith all original documents.
- (d) Candidates/Father/Mother/Relative of candidate will not have any rights for claiming compensation or to hold Indian Govt/Indian Army responsible for any injury, death, disease or disability suffered during the various physical tests undergone by the candidate at the time of recruitment. All candidates will be appearing for various tests in their own interest and risk.
- (e) Candidates not in possession of requisite certificates are liable for rejection.
- (f) In case of any clarification at rally site, approach the **‘Grievance Cell’**.
- (g) Matric certificate, Domicile (Mool Niwas) Certificate, caste certificate, police verification certificate, affidavit as per given format and Aadhar card as per admit card are mandatory during the documentation. Candidate failing to produce the same will be rejected at rally site itself.

7. **Important Instructions**

- (a) **Administration.** Candidates are advised to bring sufficient eatables and drinking water with them since recruitment is a time consuming process.
- (b) Candidates will be permitted entry into the rally site only on production of Admit Card in duplicate generated online through the official website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. Anyone found with fake admit card will be handed over to Civil Police.
- (c) Recruitment into the army is a free service. Candidates are advised not to pay bribe to any one for recruitment as it is based purely on merit. Selection process during recruitment at all stages is computerized and transparent. Therefore, candidates are advised to be beware of touts as they cannot help them at any stage.
- (d) Candidates are advised to check their age & education criteria before participating in the rally. Candidates found under age / overage and not meeting education criteria will be disqualified.
- (e) **Giving / taking bribe, production of bogus / fake certificates and indulging in unfair means is a criminal offence and liable for punishment under law.**

- (f) Certificates with overwriting, tampering of seals or erasing/alteration of any type will not be accepted.
- (g) **All documents submitted by the candidates are verified by government agencies before enrolment into Army. Strong legal action will be taken against individuals submitting fake documents. Even after recruitment, the service will be terminated if candidates are found to have produced fake documents or gave wrong information at the time of recruitment, despite the number of years of service individual may have rendered.**
- (h) **Candidates not in possession of Documents mentioned in para 5, are liable to be rejected from taking part in the Rally/selection process. All candidates are advised to carry all documents in original in their own interest. No representations will be accepted during the rally. No candidate once admitted, will be allowed to leave the rally site to bring the documents.**
- (j) No compensation for Death / injury / loss etc during the rally and no travelling allowance / dearness allowance for journey is admissible. Candidates will participate in the rally at their own risk and the participation is totally and entirely voluntary.
- (k) **Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs.** Use of any kind of performance enhancing drugs is strictly banned. Candidates having been found to have used the same will be debarred from further screening.
- (l) **Tattoo. Permanent body tattoos are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e From inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm / back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates are likely to be REJECTED for further selection.**
- (m) If 180 days or more lapse between screening medical at the rally and despatch, medical will be done again and unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.
- (n) Selection is provisional till Rahdari Certificate is issued and candidates are dispatched for training.
- (o) Mobile phones, smart watches and any other recording devices are not permitted in the rally site.
- (p) Candidates are advised in their own interest to undergo medical exam before coming for selection especially with respect to flat foot, poor vision, deformities and physical measurements. All are advised to ensure that their ears are free of wax by getting it cleaned by a doctor prior to the rally.
- (q) Candidates may have to present themselves at rally site for three to four days. Candidates should make arrangements for stay under their own arrangements.
- (r) Negative marking would be applicable in CEE.
- (s). Result of written examination will be declared on the official website **joinindianarmy.nic.in**. No separate letter will be sent to the candidate. It is the responsibility of candidate to check his result and report to ARO for documentation.
- (t) **Disclaimer.** The terms and conditions, given in the notification and on the website are subject to change and should, therefore, be treated as guidelines only.
