## SPORTS/GAMES CONSIDERED FOR BONUS MARKS

1. **Games Permitted.** Archery, Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Boxing, Cycling, Equestrian, Football, Fencing, Gymnastics, Handball, Judo, Kabbadi, Kayaking, Kho-Kho, Karate, Shooting, Rowing, Rugby, Swimming, table Tennis, Tennis, Taekwondo, Volleyball, Weight Lifting, and Wrestling.
2. **Validity.** Event of sports within two years.
3. **Position.** 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> position only for District and State level.
4. **Level.** District (Recognised by District Sports Association only), State, National and International.

## DOCUMENT TO BE BROUGHT AT RALLY SITE

1. Candidates will be permitted entry into the rally site only on production of Admit Card generated online through the Official web site joinindianarmy.nic.in.
2. 12 (twelve) copies of latest passport size coloured photographs of candidate in light blue or white background only. Photographs should **not** be attested.
3. **Original and two photocopies of the following documents :-**
  - (a) **Education Certificates.**
    - (i) **Matriculate and above candidates.** Admit card, marks sheet and board certificate of class 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>.
    - (ii) **Non matriculate candidates.** Transfer certificate and marks sheet of class 8<sup>th</sup> countersigned by Inspector of Schools and District Education Officer with rubber stamp, round stamp and mobile No of signing officer. Birth certificate issued by Registrar, births and deaths.
  - (b) Permanent residential certificate/Domicile certificate with color photo of candidate signed by DM/SDM/DC/ADC affixed with rubber stamp and office seal.
  - (c) Caste/Tribe certificate with photo of candidate signed by DM/SDM/DC/ADC affixed with rubber stamp and office seal.
  - (d) Character certificate not older than six months from Headmaster/Village headman/Police Station duly signed, affixed with rubber stamp and round stamp.
  - (e) NCC A/B/C certificate for NCC cadets affixed with photo, signed by issuing authority and affixed with rubber stamp and round stamp.
  - (e) Unmarried Certificate for candidates below 21 years signed by village headman with official stamp and signatures stating that candidate is unmarried. The certificate should not be more than six months old.
  - (f) Sports certificate for representing India at International level, State at National level, District at State level and University team or Regional team at District level and secured 1<sup>st</sup> /2<sup>nd</sup> position only not older than two years on the date of screening.
  - (g) Gorkha caste certificate with details of name, father's name, mother's name, address, religion, caste, sub caste signed by candidate and countersigned by village headman and affidavit on non judicial stamp paper of Rs 10/- signed by Notary Public.
4. Discharge book duly endorsed with correct name and date of birth of candidate and his father/relationship certificate issued by Record Office with number, rank and name of signing authority for son of service man, ex-serviceman, war widow and widow.
5. Voter list authenticated by District Electoral Officer.

### SAY NO TO TATOOS

**“Permanent body tattoos are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e. from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection”.**

### BEWARE OF TOUTS

**“The recruitment process is fully automated, computer based and coded for secrecy. There are multiple independent boards of officers detailed for recruitment at various stages. Software encryption procedures are used to ensure fair and transparent selection of meritorious candidates. Rely on yourself, no one can help you get recruitment in the Indian army. Beware of touts. Do not engage them. They are only fleecing you by giving false assurances and hopes. Don't waste your parent's hard earned money. Do not hand over your original documents/certificates to touts, they will black mail you. Recruitment is open, free, fair and merit based”.**
